ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 19, 1998, Intermedia Communications Inc. (Intermedia) filed a Petition for Arbitration under 47 U.S.C. §252(d), seeking arbitration of certain unresolved issues in its replacement interconnection agreement negotiations with BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth). BellSouth responded on December 14, 1998. This matter was set for an arbitration hearing on March 18, 22, 23, and 24, 1999.

On February 16, 1999, Intermedia and BellSouth entered into an agreement settling the arbitration proceeding in Florida. The agreement provides for the extension of the interconnection agreement between Intermedia and Bellsouth to December 31, 1999, in exchange for Intermedia's withdrawal of i's arbitration petitions in the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, South Carolina, and Tennessee. BellSouth agrees that there is no longer a need for arbitration at this time.

On February 22, 1999, Intermedia filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Petition for Arbitration without prejudice. On March 16, 1999, we approved a staff recommendation to close the docket due to Intermedia's withdrawal of its petition. In light of Intermedia's
