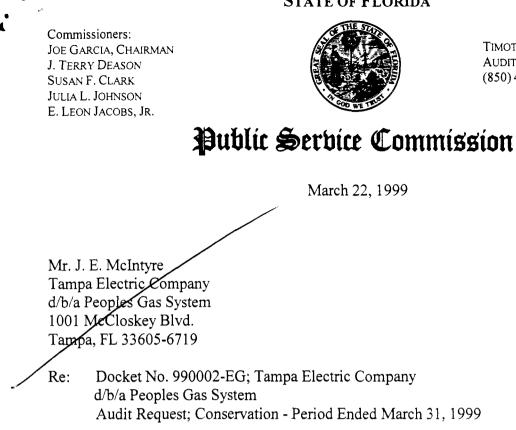

**AUDITING & FINANCIAL ANALYSIS** 



Dear Mr. McIntyre:

The Florida Public Service Commission will conduct a conservation audit for the period ended March 31, 1999 in accordance with Commission audit procedures. Access will be requested to documents and records of the utility and, if necessary, supporting records for affiliate company transactions that affect regulated operations. Staff auditors may also request to review the utility's external audit working papers for the most recent independent audit. James McPherson, (813) 744-6093, the district office supervisor, will coordinate this audit. Questions regarding the audit or audit staff should be directed to the district supervisor or myself. The Audit Access to Records rule for each industry states:

ACK	In those instances where the utility disagrees with the auditor's assessment of a reasonable response time to the audit request, the utility shall first attempt to discuss the disagreement with the auditor and reach an acceptable revised date.
