I am in receipt of your fax dated March 11, 1999, providing copies of applications submitted by Fiveland Investments, Inc., and Rotonda West Utilities Corporation.

I have reviewed the area in question and am providing herewith a drawing indicating the existing boundary lines and the area of apparent conflict. As you can see, if the area in conflict (indicated by red cross hatch) were to be included in Rotonda West (Aqua Source) the affect would be to bisect the large single parcel of undeveloped land currently serviced by Charlotte County Utilities (Fiveland). As indicated on the map, Charlotte County presently owns the water transmission main fronting the subject parcel and providing service to existing customers on the opposite side of SR 775. The Rotonda West Utility system does not currently have water or sewer lines extending to the subject parcel.

Based upon that information and in response to your questions, #2 and #3, this territory is currently serviced by Charlotte County Utilities and the County would object to the transfer of this area to Rotonda West.

In response to your initial question, which utility was granted the overlapping first, I have been unable to locate any definitive authority within our records. As you are aware, regulatory authority over investor-owned utilities in Charlotte County has been transferred on numerous occasions between the County and Florida Public Service Commission. I have, however, determined that Fiveland Investments, Inc., previously held Certificate #312-A issued by the FPSC. This Certificate was transferred to Charlotte County and at the time the Board of County Commissioners approved Certificate #81-0002, the accompanying legal description for service area included the subject property.

With regard to the provision of wastewater service, it is my understanding that when the utility (Fiveland) was originally formed, the developer contemplated both water and wastewater services. Services were subsequently split with water provided by Fiveland Investments, Inc., and wastewater being provided by Sandalhaven Utilities. You may wish to review the files relating to Sandalhaven to determine if this same conflict exists with regard to the application filed by Aqua Source.

In closing, I would point out that Order #PSC95-0613-FOF-WU grants a certificated area to Fiveland effective May 22, 1995, where as Order #PSC95-0780-FOF-WS granting the area to Rotonda was not issued until June 28, 1995.


