<u>Issue 2</u>: Should the transfer of Wastewater Certificate No. 495-S from Sandalhaven Utility, Inc., to Utilities, Inc. of Sandalhaven be approved? <u>Recommendation</u>: Yes, the transfer should be approved. Wastewater Certificate No. 495-S, held by Sandalhaven Utility, Inc., should be transferred to Utilities, Inc. of Sandalhaven. Utilities, Inc. of Sandalhaven should also be required to provide a recorded copy of the deed within 60 days from the issuance date of the order issued as a result of action taken at this agenda conference.

<u>Issue 3</u>: What is the rate base of Sandalhaven at the time of transfer? <u>Recommendation</u>: The rate base, which for transfer purposes reflects the net book value, is \$30,378 for the wastewater system as of August 31, 1998.

<u>Issue 4</u>: Should a positive acquisition adjustment be approved? <u>Recommendation</u>: No. A positive acquisition adjustment should not be included in the calculation of rate base for transfer purposes. <u>Issue 5</u>: Should Utilities, Inc. of Sandalhaven adopt and use the rates and charges approved by this Commission for Sandalhaven Utility, Inc.? <u>Recommendation</u>: Yes, Utilities, Inc. of Sandalhaven should continue charging the rates and charges approved for this utility system until authorized to change by this Commission in a subsequent proceeding. The tariff reflecting the change in ownership should be effective for services provided or connections made on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff sheets.

Issue_6: Should this docket be closed?

<u>Recommendation</u>: No. Upon expiration of the protest period, this docket should remain open for an additional 60 days to allow staff to verify that Utilities, Inc. of Sandalhaven has submitted a recorded deed. Once the recorded deed has been submitted, this docket should be closed administratively.
