APPELLANT FLORIDA POWER CORPORATION'S RESPONSE TO MOTION FOR CONSOLIDATION OF APPEALS FOR PURPOSES OF SCHEDULING, ORAL ARGUMENT, AND DECISION

Appellant, Florida Power Corporation (FPC), responds to the Motion for Consolidation of Appeals for Purposes of Scheduling, Oral Argument, and Decision filed by Miami-Dade County, Florida (Dade) and Montenay-Dade, Ltd. (Montenay) in case No. 94,664, and states as follows:

1. FPC does not object in concept to this motion under the circumstances existing at this time. The Court should be aware, however, that the procedural postures underlying case No. 94,664 and case No. 94,665 are quite different at the time of this appeal. Among other things, the trial proceedings between FPC and Lake Cogen, Ltd. (Lake), on the one hand, and FPC and - Dade and Montenay, on the other hand, have proceeded at disparate paces. While FPC does not believe this precludes consolidation at this time, it reserves the right to request deconsolidation if those different procedural postures become _ relevant in this appeal.

2. Moreover, any consolidation should recognize that FPC continues to be represented by separate counsel in the DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

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Montenay/Dade and Lake matters, including these different appeals,¹ and hence will be presenting separate briefs and oral arguments, as its interests may appear.
