Dear Ms. Marek:

FCC Order 99-54, released March 23, 1999, states:

On June 22, 1999, if a state commission has not yet acted on a LEC's intraLATA toll dialing parity implementation plan, the LEC must file that plan with the Common Carrier Bureau. By June 23, 1999, the Bureau will release a public notice initiating a comment cycle for the Bureau's consideration of any LEC plan filed with the Bureau. A state commission may continue to act on a plan until the Bureau has acted upon that plan. A LEC's failure to file a plan with the state commission or this Commission in the manner required by this order will be deemed a violation of this Commission's rules that will allow interested parties to seek relief pursuant to section 401(b) of the Act.

The intraLATA toll dialing parity plan filed by Time Warner on May 27, 1999, in Docket 990546-TP, was not received in time to be considered by the Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC) at its June 1, 1999 Agenda Conference. However, since FCC Order 99-54 allows the state commission to continue to review a plan until the Common Carrier Bureau has acted, we will review the plan filed by Time Warner and submit a recommendation to the FPSC in the near future. Please note that the earliest this matter could be acted upon by the FPSC is June 29, 1999; therefore, I suggest you file your plan with the FCC's Common Carrier Bureau by June 22, 1999 as directed in FCC Order 99-54.
