PETITION TO INTERVENE OF SPRINT COMMUNICATIONS COMPANY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP AND SPRINT-FLORIDA INCORPORATED

COMES NOW Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership and Sprint-Florida, Incorporated ("Sprint") by and through its undersigned attorneys, pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, files its Petition to Intervene. In support thereof Sprint states as follows:

Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership is an Alternative Local Exchange Company (ALEC) authorized by the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") to operate as an Alternative Local Exchange Carrier. Sprint-Florida, Incorporated is a Local Exchange Company (ILEC) authorized by the Florida Public Service Commission to provide local exchange service in the State of Florida.

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- 3. The instant proceeding involves proposals regarding the pricing of network elements, requirements to make them available and the performance of cost studies, among others. Sprint offers and intends to offer competitive services that will require access to reasonably and lawfully priced elements of the incumbent local exchange carriers. In its capacity as an ILEC, Sprint will be subject to requests for unbundling and pricing of network elements. As both an ILEC and a CLEC, Sprint will be affected by any determination made by the Commission in this docket.
