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CITIZENS' REQUEST FOR ENTRY ON TO LAND, FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSPECTION, AND TAKING OF SAMPLES

Pursuant to Rule 1.350, Florida Rule of Civil Procedure, the Citizens of the State of Florida, by and through JACK SHREVE, Public Counsel, (Citizens) request of Aloha Utilities, Inc. (Aloha) that the Citizens (by representative(s)) be permitted to enter upon the lands of Aloha, to inspect certain facilities thereon, and to take samples of raw and or treated water, and say:

- 1. Rule 1.350, Fla. R.Civ. P. permits any party to request any other party to permit entry upon designated land or other property in the possession or control of the party upon whom the request is served for the purpose of inspection, testing, or sampling;
- 2. The Citizens request that their representative(s) be permitted to enter upon the lands of each and every water production and/or treatment facility from which water served to the customers of Aloha's Seven Springs Water System is either produced or treated; to thoroughly inspect each of those facilities, and to extract such samples of water, both treated and raw, as may appear reasonable to the Citizens' representative(s);
- 3. The Citizens request that such entry upon land, attending inspections, and sampling be permitted by Aloha Utilities, Inc, on August 4, 1999, and to continue until such inspections and sampling are complete; or at such other time upon which counsel may agree in writing.

4. Rule 1.350, Fla. R.Civ. P. further provides:

The party to whom the request is directed shall serve a written response within 30 days after service of the request,

For each item or category the response shall state that inspection and related activities will be permitted as requested unless the request is objected to, in which event the reasons for the objection shall be stated.

Order No. PSC-96-0772-PCO-WS, the Commission's most recent order establishing procedure in this docket, provides in part:

Discovery

When discovery requests are served and the respondent intends to object to or ask for clarification of the discovery request, the objection or request for clarification shall be made within ten days of service of the discovery request. This procedure is intended to reduce delay in resolving discovery disputes.

The Citizens hereby request a response on or before August 2, 1999, specifically and unequivocally permitting the requested entry, inspection, and sampling; or if there be any objections raised to the requested entry, inspection, and sampling, that such objections be furnished to the Citizens on or before July 13, 1999, setting forth each objection with specificity.

In the spirit of facilitating this discovery and lessening the likelihood of disputes related thereto, the Citizens will advance no objection to any condition directly relating to security and safety issues advanced by Aloha, but will contest any condition relating to the selection of the Citizens'

representative(s) and/or any condition relating to sampling methods, their adequacy, or any other matter relating to the quality of evidence which the Citizens' representative(s) may acquire.
