RE: DOCKET NO. 990779-TC - Initiation of show cause proceedings against Southern Telecom, Inc. for apparent violation of Rule 25-24.515, F.A.C., Pay Telephone Service.

<u>Issue 1</u>: Should Southern Telecom, Inc. be ordered to show cause why a fine of \$300 for apparent violations of Rule 25-24.515, Florida Administrative Code, Pay Telephone Service, should not be imposed or Certificate No. 2805 should not be canceled?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should order Southern to show cause in writing within 21 days of the date of the order why it should not have Certificate No. 2805 canceled or be fined \$300 for apparent violation of Rule 25-24.515, Florida Administrative Code. Southern's response must contain specific allegations of fact or law. If Southern fails to respond to the show cause, and the fine is not paid after reasonable collection efforts by the Commission, Certificate No. 2805 should be canceled. If the fine is paid it will be remitted by the Commission to the State of Florida General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285, Florida Statutes.

the show cause order, this docket should remain open pending resolution of
the show cause proceeding. If the fine is paid, it should be forwarded to
the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the General Revenue Fund
pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes, and this docket should be
closed. Staff recommends that if Southern fails to respond to the Order to
Show Cause, and the fine is not received within five business days after
expiration of the show cause response period, Southern's certificate should
be canceled and this docket closed.
