Please accept for filing the original and fifteen (15) copies of this letter and the attached correspondence dated May 27, 1999 from Sam Waters to Jim Dean as Florida Power & Light Company's ("FPL") request for a rule development workshop in the above-numbered and entitled proceeding. This request is made pursuant to Rule 28-103.002 of the Florida Administrative Code.

FPL submits that a series of workshops should be conducted prior to proposing rules for adoption. The issues to be addressed are complex and potentially controversial. Further, the establishment of such interconnection requirements necessarily will involve competing points of view and interests and will have a significant impact on regulated interests. A rule development workshop would assist the Commission to better understand and address the concerns of the affected entities, including investor-owned utilities such as FPL.

This letter is in regard to the opening of Docket No. 990538-EI, establishment of electric requirements for small photovoltaic systems (10Kw or less) requesting interconnection and parallel operation with an investor owned utility.


As you are aware, Staff issued it's CASR for this docket. Staff recommendation is slated for June 24, 1999, and will be put before the Commission for vote during their July 6, 1999 Agenda Conference. While a docket has been opened, and a CASR issued, as of this date the particulars of this docket have not been identified nor published in a formal proceeding.

FPL feels that this does not afford us enough time to address the issues that were discussed with you during our March 19 conference call. The issues we discussed were:

- 1. Reduction of insurance premiums from \$1,000,000 to \$100,000
- 2. Cross subsidization from other FPL ratepayers
- 3. Proper cost allocation (proposed FPL rider)
- 4. Certification and installation process, i.e., who will be the entity responsible for the certification and the inspection of the PV installations?
- 5. Proposed Pilot Program

These are some of the issues that FPL initially identified and brought to your attention during our conference call. Now that a docket has been initiated, we would like the opportunity to formally address those issues and others that have recently been identified in a forum such as a series of workshops or other formal proceeding, before Staff issues their recommendation to the Commission.

FPL would also like to find out if this docket will still be limited to the subject of modifying the interconnection standards for small photovoltaic systems in residential dwellings as stated in your electronic mail to FPL's Sean McCarthy (dated February 2, 1999), or if this docket will be opened to other distributed generation interests.
