Green Pricing R&D Project Eighth Quarterly Report Report Period: Second Quarter 1999

PERIOD FOR ACTIVITIES:

April, May and June 1999

The FPL Green Pricing Research and Development Project (GPRDP) was approved by the Commission in Order No. PSC-97-FOF-0528-EG, dated May 7, 1997. This program is designed to allow FPL the flexibility to test FPL customer response to a Green Pricing Initiative. Under the GPRDP, FPL will solicit contributions from its customers to be used to purchase, install, maintain and operate Photovoltaic (PV) modules in FPL's system.

FPL is completing the design and implementation phases for this project.

ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED:

- 1. FPL has awarded an installation contract to the successful bidder, Advance Solar Systems, Inc.
- 2. Work is underway; however, the inverter, a critical component of the system, has not been shipped. The manufacturer of the inverter has experienced a delay in receiving upstream components. This is expected to delay completion of the project until July 30, 1999. All other components of the system are installed and ready for operation.

CONTRIBUTIONS:

The goal of \$70,000 was exceeded, therefore, contribution activity was terminated. The amounts received and numbers of contributions remain as reported in the Fourth Quarter "1998" Report.

BUDGET/EXPENDITURES:

The GPRDP has an approved two year cost cap of \$475,000
