The Commission should order Florida Pay Phone Systems, Inc. to show cause in writing within 21 days of the date of the order why it should not have Certificate No. 3778 canceled or be fined \$300 for apparent violations of Rule 25-24.515, Florida Administrative Code. Florida Pay Phone Systems, Inc.'s response must contain specific allegations of fact or law. If Florida Pay Phone Systems, Inc. fails to respond to the show cause, and the fine is not paid after reasonable

collection efforts by the Commission, Certificate No. 3778 should be canceled. If the fine is paid it will be remitted by the Commission to the State of Florida General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285, Florida Statutes.

## Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: If staff's recommendation in Issue 1 is approved, then Florida Pay Phone Systems, Inc. will have 21 days from issuance of the Commission's show cause order to respond in writing why it should not be fined in the amount proposed or have its certificate canceled. If Florida Pay Phone Systems, Inc. timely responds to the show cause order, this docket should remain open pending resolution of the show cause proceeding. If the fine is paid, it should be forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes, and this docket should be closed. Staff recommends that if Florida Pay Phone Systems, Inc. fails to respond to the Order to Show Cause, and the fine is not received within five business days after expiration of the show cause response period, Florida Pay Phone Systems, Inc.'s certificate should be canceled and this docket closed.
