Attached is a facsimile letter received on July 21, 1999, from Mr. Jim McGee, Esquire, counsel for Florida Power Corporation (FPC). Mr. McGee requests that Item Nine, staff's recommendation in Docket No. 990538-EI, be deferred until the August 31, 1999, Agenda. Mr. McGee's letter indicates that FPC and the Disney Wilderness Preserve are currently modifying the agreement that is the subject of staff's recommendation.

Mr. McGee and Mr. Wade Litchfield, Esquire, intervenor FPL's counsel, indicated to staff in telephone conversations July 22, 1999, that their clients would like the opportunity to workshop the issues in this docket before any agreement goes to Agenda. Staff believes that deferring this item indefinitely may be the most prudent course. Both the OCR and OPR concur that it is advisable to defer this item pending further review of the revised interconnection agreement and the conclusion of a workshop on the issues raised in this docket.


