Communications Billing, Inc. ("CBI"), by its attorneys, hereby notifies the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") of the proposed transfer of ownership or control of CBI from its current shareholders through the assignment of all of CBI's corporate stock. It is our understanding that under the circumstances set forth below, no formal approval of the Commission is required for this transaction.

CBI, a Ohio corporation, is authorized to provide intrastate toll telecommunication services in Florida.¹ In addition, CBI is currently authorized as a reseller of intrastate, interexchange telecommunications services in 38 states. It also is authorized by the Federal Communications Commission to resell interstate and international service.

On August 5, 1999, the shareholders of CBI executed an Irrevocable Assignment of Stock and Power of Attorney Upon Conditions Met (the "Agreement") transferring all issued and outstanding capital stock of CBI from the current shareholders to Thomas M. Coughlin, Sr. and Philip A. Bethune. The transfer contemplated within the Agreement is expressly contingent upon CBI receiving requisite regulatory approval for the transaction of ownership or control.

The transfer of ownership or control of CBI from its current shareholders is in the public The new shareholders will enhance CBI's ability to compete in the market for telecommunication services in Florida and elsewhere. CBI believes this transaction will permit CBI to operate more efficiently and thus to compete more effectively.

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In addition, CBI will have access to the financial resources it needs to introduce new products and services and to respond to competition in the competitive telecommunications environment in Florida. After the transfer of ownership or control, CBI will continue to operate as it has in the past, using the same name, tariff, and operating authority. Thus, the transfer of ownership or control will be transparent to, and will have no adverse impact upon the CBI's customers.
