Dear Sir or Madam:

On January 19, 1999, SmarTalk TeleServices and its subsidiaries (collectively, "SmarTalk") filed a Chapter 11 Petition in Bankruptcy with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, docketed as *Worldwide Direct Inc. et al, Case Nos. 99-108 through 99-127 (MFW)*. At the same time, ATT and SmarTalk entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement, whereby AT&T would purchase substantially all of the assets of SmarTalk, including, but not limited to, the prepaid calling card obligations of SmarTalk to its end users.

Accordingly, SmarTalk hereby requests that the Commission withdraw its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, granted under Docket Number 95-0350-TI, on May 22, 1995. Such withdrawal should be effective immediately. Prepaid cards currently in circulation will be serviced by ATT, which will provide such services pursuant to the terms of its tariffs, will have been or will be amended to reflect the products offered by SmarTalk.
