A single area code for Volusia and Flagler

olusia County is already a divided place—east and west, beach and river, urbanites and small-towners. Now the phone companies want to add one more divider, another area code. That shouldn't happen.

BellSouth and Sprint have recommended adding a third area code in Volusia County that would apply to every new number they assign. So if your home number has a 904 or 407 area code and you add an extra line for your teen-ager so you can actually use the phone once in a while, the new number would have a different area code.

Doing that might be the easiest thing for the phone companies, but it sure is a hardship for everyone else. It means county residents would have to dial 10 digits whether they're calling New York or their office. It means adding untold minutes to their dialing time when they have to look up the area code every time they call, whether it's to the new neighbor or to the familiar drug store.

The Florida Public Service Commission, which will decide the issue, ought to pay more heed to hundreds of thousands of telephone users' needs than to two telephone companies' wants. The fact is, there's a simple solution. It's no secret that the 904 area code will run out in 2001, and Jacksonville is siated to keep it. So Volusia and Flagler and the 13 other counties that currently use 904 will need new ones.

The PSC should unite Volusia and Flagler counties under a single common area code now, instead of adding new codes on top of existing ones. Otherwise, some predict this area could have as many as five area codes in five years. That's madness.

The difficulty lies in persuading the commission to take the sensible — rather than the expedient — action. But it can be done. Brevard

Residents shouldn't have to dial 10 digits to call the office or the neighbor next door.

County faced a similar situation and prevailed. That community united to save itself from 10-digit dialing and multiple area codes. For its efforts, the PSC awarded Brevard a signature area code for the region, 321 (blastoff).

This region's leaders should be heartened by Brevard's victory and consider using its blueprint for success. That county's disparate groups — businesses, residents, cities and county governments — advocated loudly for one area code. Their united front convinced utilities commissioners a single area code was the best thing for the public good. It wouldn't have happened if the different concerns had offered fractured and contradictory opinions, as is frequently the case here.

Differences are already surfacing. Some Deltona residents fear relinquishing their 407 code will mean they'll have to pay more to call Seminole and Orange counties. It's not true. The PSC has agreed to keep the cost of Deltonans' westward calls the same.

Besides convenience and clarity, placing all of Volusia and Flagler counties under one area code would help connect the diverse region. To share an area code is to share an identity, a unifier in the psyche's information data bank.

From Daytona Beach to Deltona, Palm Coast to Port Orange, this area needs things to bring it together. An area code may simply be a symbol of unity, but it's an important one. Local leaders should work to make it happen.



VOLUSIA COUNTY AREA CODE

. BACKGROUND

The Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) warned March 25 that the 904 area code - which covers most of Volusia County and Northeast Florida - would be exhausted much sooner than expected. The PSC said several other area codes for the Florida Keys, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, and Indian River counties were also about to expire. In addition, the 407 area code is running out of numbers and a new 10-digit dialing requirement will go into effect in Orange County next year.

The explosion of new telephone lines for fax machines, cellular phones and Internet access makes it difficult to make projections on future area-code needs. Therefore, the PSC, at its last meeting, agreed to slow the rate at which new telephone numbers are distributed. Currently, numbers are given to telephone companies in blocks of 10,000. That system has been criticized because start-up telephone companies with few customers often do not need that many numbers. Therefore, tens of thousands of telephone numbers go unused. With these safeguards in place, the PSC now predict the 904 numbers will last until the second quarter of 2002.

Possible outcomes for Volusia County could mean a new area code, keeping the 904 area code, area overlays (10-digit dialing), or splitting the county's even further.

The Volusia Council of Governments (VCOG), alarmed at the possibility of this dilemma, began organizing a campaign for a new area code for all Volusia and possibly Flagler counties when 904 runs out of numbers. The Council has initiated campaign to rid Volusia of its 407/904 split and gain a new number. The new exchange also is needed if Volusia County is to be united in a new area code when 904 expires.

One drawback for Volusia County is its size. Volusia County is currently split between the 904 and 407 area codes. One area code may utilize up to 8 million numbers. Volusia will have to compete with Jacksonville (Duval County) to maintain 904. Last year, Jacksonville, which includes several military installations, was successful in maintaining the 904 area code over Tallahassee (Leon County).

POSITION

The Daytona Beach/Halifax Area Chamber agrees to work with the Volusia Council of Governments and other business organizations to initiate a proactive campaign to inform the business community of the area code issue and develop a desired plan of action for Volusia County.
