As of this writing the FCC has not issued its order on the remand of Rule 319 (319 order) by the Supreme Court. Therefore, we want to advise you that the dates set for direct supplemental testimony and rebuttal of the direct supplemental testimony are no longer valid.

We want to provide you with the best opportunity to file substantive testimony concerning the 319 order and its impact on our proceeding; however, as you know there is no date certain for the 319 order release. Therefore, staff has developed two scenarios. Unfortunately, under both scenarios staff believes that there is insufficient time for both direct supplemental testimony and rebuttal of the direct. Therefore, only direct supplemental testimony may be filed, and it may only be filed on the 319 order's impact on Phase I of this proceeding.

The first scenario assumes that the FCC releases its order no later than Monday, October 26, 1999. Under this scenario, direct supplemental testimony may be filed no later than Tuesday, November 9, 1999.

The second scenario assumes that the FCC releases its order after Monday, October 26, 1999 but prior to Tuesday, November 16, 1999. Under this assumption, direct supplemental testimony may be filed no later than Monday, November 29, 1999.
