Just to prove that you will always receive "friendly advice" - no matter how good the news:	
I first applaud the recent settlement plan approved by the Florida Public Service Commission on the largest rate reduction in the state's history with Florida Power & Light.	
But, I would like to make an observation.	
No major corporation would ever offer such a swift and generous proposal unless the actual end-results were in their favor.	
Where I see the hidden benefit to FPL:	
The rate reduction was applied in only one place - per kWh charges. All FPL rates have multiple charge points that make up the total monthly charges for customers. But, the agreed upon rate reduction is applied to every rate on the exact same billing component (kWh).	
Which in fact, is exactly the only place on the entire bill threatened by the possibility of future competition.	
Lowering the only portion of the bill facing this possibility, FPL has, in essence, possibly priced out the threat of competition. Also, they have established or maintained a higher rate level on the parts of the monthly bill not facing competition.	AFA
An even better deal for FPL electric customers would have been a rate reduction applied "across the board." This would have forced FPL to establish pricing in the noncompetitive portion of the monthly bill and forced them to become even more efficient and customer-focused.	CAF CMU EAG LEG MAS
Instead, the reduction on the possible competitive portion may have cemented FPL's ability to remain our only choice.	RRR SEC WAW
