Lucky Dog Phone Co. and d/b/a ACC Business.

By Order No. PSC-99-1920-PAA-TI, issued September 28, 1999, the Commission ordered the company to refund interest on the overcharged amount and return all unrefunded overcharges and interest to the Commission for deposit in the General Revenue Fund. On January 21, 2000, AT&T delivered a check to the Commission for \$7,167.55 for all unrefunded monies. AT&T overcharged \$1,076,454.61, plus had to refund \$33,681.56 in interest. The company was able to refund \$1,073,675.44 in overcharges and \$29,293.18 in interest, for a total of \$1,102,968.62. This left a balance of \$2,779.17 for the amount of overcharges that could not be refunded, plus \$4,388.38 in interest that could not be refunded, for a grand total of \$7,167.55. Accordingly, this docket should be closed.
