Dear Mr. Murphy:

This is in response to your letter dated January 14 in response to Order No. PSC-99-2482-PAA-TC, issued on December 20, 1999, which imposed a \$500 fine or canceled your certificate. As information, if a certificate is active for any given day during a calendar year, regulatory assessment fees (RAF) are owed for that year. The fee is .0015% of intrastate revenues, or a minimum of \$50, whichever is greater.

In this case, your certificate became active July 14, 1998. The regulatory assessment fee return was mailed December 10, 1998 and became due February 1, 1999. Since the 1998 RAF, plus statutory penalty and interest charges, has not yet been paid, this must be paid immediately. If you owe the minimum, the amount due is the \$50.00 fee, \$12.50 penalty, and \$6.00 interest if your payment is postmarked in January 2000, for a total of \$68.50. If your payment is postmarked in February 2000, the minimum interest charge increases to \$6.50, for a total due of \$69.00. Another copy of the 1998 RAF form is attached.

In addition to paying the past due amount, along with the accrued penalty and interest charges, the company needs to make a settlement offer to resolve this docket. In other cases dealing with this rule violation, the Commission has accepted a \$100 settlement in lieu of the \$500 fine normally imposed. The settlement letter needs to include the following:
