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<u>Issue 2</u>: Should any amount of annual wastewater revenue be held subject to refund, and, if so, what is the appropriate amount?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes, the utility should hold annual wastewater revenues of \$53,860 subject to refund. The following amounts are recommended:

1998 Revenue \$350,194

Amount Subject to Refund \$ 53,860 Percent Subject to Refund 15.38%

Issue 3: What is the appropriate security to guarantee the amount subject
to refund?

Recommendation: The utility should be required to file a corporate undertaking to guarantee the amount subject to refund. The corporate undertaking should be in the amount of \$45,000. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.360(6), Florida Administrative Code, the utility should be required to provide a report by the 20th of each month indicating the monthly and total revenue collected subject to refund. The utility should be put on notice that failure to comply with these requirements will result in the initiation of a show cause proceeding.
