Now that the Commission has disposed of the Intervenors' Motions for Rehearing, NFMU needs to move forward with billing the customers in accordance with the Settlement Agreement which was adopted by the Commission. I would suggest that NFMU bill the Buccaneer customers each month for two months of usage until they get caught up. Thus, the billing schedule would be as follows:

February - usage for September and October, 1999 March - usage for November and December, 1999 April - usage for January and February, 2000 May - usage for March and April, 2000

We would expect the first bill to be mailed in mid-February, 2000. Although NFMU believes that it would have the right under the Settlement Agreement to demand payment of the past bills in total, we believe this is a fair procedure to utilize.
