NOTICE OF WAIVER OF DISQUALIFICATION

ISSUED: March 2, 2000

Commissioner Jaber has been assigned to hear the above-referenced docket. Because the Commission's role in deciding this case is quasi-judicial, the Code of Judicial Conduct should be applied. Canons 3E and F of the Code of Judicial Conduct provides that when a judge's impartiality might reasonably be questioned because she was involved in a case as a lawyer, the judge may participate in the proceeding if all the parties and lawyers agree in writing to waive the disqualification under a procedure independent of the judge's participation.

Thus, unless a waiver from all parties and all counsel is received, Commissioner Jaber intends to disqualify in the abovereferenced proceeding because of her previous involvement in the case which consisted of drafting recommendations and orders, attending informal meetings with staff and parties, participating in Agenda. If you and your client(s) wish to waive Commissioner Jaber's disqualification, letters to that effect from you and from your client(s) must be sent to Blanca Bayó, Director of the Division of Records and Reporting, at the below listed address within seven (7) days of the date of this Notice. letters should not be sent to Commissioner Jaber and copies should not be sent to other counsel. If all parties and all counsel submit such letters, this Notice and all responses will be made part of the record, as required by Canon 3D of the Code of Judicial Conduct, and Commissioner Jaber will continue participation in the proceeding.

If waivers are not received from all parties and all counsel, the responses will not be shown to Commissioner Jaber nor will Commissioner Jaber be informed of the identity of any party or lawyer who declined to waive the disqualification. If the disqualification is not waived, this case will be reassigned.
