COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and files its Motion for Extension of Duration of Order Granting Confidential Classification and Motion for Protective Order, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

- 1. On September 13, 1996, BellSouth filed a Request for Confidential Classification and Motion for Permanent Protective Order for cost and vendor specific information.
- 2. By Order No. PSC-98-1321-CFO-TP, issued October 9, 1998, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") granted BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification and Motion for Protective Order of Documents Nos. 09027-96, 09097-96 and 09099-96.
- 3. Under the provisions of Rule 25-22.006(9), an order granting confidential classification is effective for 18 months. Therefore, the confidential classification granted in these Orders expires on April 9, 2000.
  - 4. The information requested remains in the possession of Staff.
- 5. The reasons BellSouth asserted in support of confidential treatment in its original motion continue to pertain. Specifically, there is still a need to protect cost and vendor specific information.
- 6. For the reasons set forth above, and in the original Request for Confidential Classification and Motion for Permanent Protective Order filed on September 13, 1996, BellSouth hereby requests that this Commission enter an Order extending the period of confidential classification for an additional 18 months, or for any longer period of time that the documents remain within the possession of Staff.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, BellSouth respectfully requests the entry of an Order extending the period of confidential classification as described above.
