On March 10th, 1999 I purchased five pay phones from AC TELCOMM, L.C. at 5415 Springfield Ave Suite #3B Laredo, Texas 78041. The president of this company is Carlos Tejada.

This was to be a business venture, however after receiving the pay phones I discovered that they were all defective. In the package with the telephones I received a program sheet that was four pages long and totally incomprehensible. No one in Florida was able to help with the programming of the phones and upon trying to make contact with AC TELCOMM I discovered that their phone has been disconnected.

I am out of pocket the sum of \$4,500. This is \$2,500, the price of the pay phones, other expenses (i.e. permits, connection fees, and locating company.) amount to \$2,000 (all receipts were kept for these purchases).

Kindly investigate this company and advise me of any action that I may be able to initiate, in order to recoup my losses.
