### BY THE COMMISSION:

The entities listed below currently hold a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorizing the provision of Shared Tenant service. All entities that apply for certification receive a copy of our rules governing Shared Tenant service. All applicants must attest that these rules have been received and understood by the applicant and an affidavit must be attached to the application in order for the application to be processed.

Pursuant to Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, certificate holders must pay a minimum annual RAF of \$50 if the certificate was active during any portion of the calendar year. The RAFs form was mailed to each of these entities for the period of January 1 through December 31. Pursuant to Rule 25-4.0161(2), Florida Administrative Code, the form and applicable fees are due to the Florida Public Service Commission by January 30 of the subsequent year. However, pursuant to Section 350.113(4), Florida Statutes, the Commission shall provide at least a 45 days notice of the date the payment is due prior to the due date. Each of the entities listed was scheduled to remit its RAFs by February 1, 1999.

After this docket was opened, each of the entities contacted our staff, paid the past due amounts in full, and proposed a settlement offer. Each of the entities proposed to pay future RAFs in a timely manner, and contribute \$100 to the State General Revenue Fund.

We believe that the terms of the settlement agreement represent a fair and reasonable resolution of this matter. Accordingly, we hereby accept the settlement offers. Each of the entities must comply with these requirements within ten business days from the date this Order becomes final. The contribution should be identified with the docket number and the entity's name. The contributions will be forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If an entity fails to comply with this Order, its certificate will be canceled

ORDERED that these dockets shall remain open pending receipt of each of the \$100 contribution. The contributions will be transmitted to the Comptroller for deposit in the State of Florida General Revenue Fund. It is further

ORDERED that if an entity fails to comply with this Order, its Shared Tenant Service Certificate will be canceled administratively. It is further

ORDERED that upon receipt of each of the \$100 contribution or cancellation of the certificate, each docket shall be closed.
