Pursuant to Order No. PSC-00-0575-PAA-WS, issued March 22, 2000, in the abovereferenced dockets, the Commission approved a February 9, 2000 Settlement Agreement and Stipulation filed by Florida Water Services Corporation and Lake Suzy Utilities, Inc. (Lake Suzy). Pursuant to the Order, the Commission also granted Lake Suzy Water Certificate No. 599-W and Wastewater Certificate No. 514-S to provide service in DeSoto and Charlotte Counties. By the proposed agency action portion of that Order, the Commission also approved rates and charges for Lake Suzy. Finally, the Commission required that the dockets remain open pending verification by Lake Suzy of a refund to a customer in Charlotte County. Consummating Order No. PSC-00-0723-CO-WS, issued April 14, made Order No. PSC-00-0575-PAA-WS effective and final and ordered that the dockets remain open as required by that Order.

Lake Suzy has provided the necessary information indicating that the customer in Charlotte County received a refund as required by the Commission. There are no outstanding matters to be addressed by the Commission; therefore, these dockets should be closed.
