<u>Issue 2</u>: Should these dockets be closed?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes. If the Commission approves or modifies staff's recommendation on Issue 1, these dockets should be closed upon receipt of the fees or cancellation of the certificate, unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's decision files a protest within 21 days of the issuance of the proposed agency action order. If the Commission denies staff's recommendation on Issue 1, these dockets should be closed administratively. A protest in one docket should not prevent the action in a separate docket from becoming final.
