### Dear Tyler:

You have asked that I address two issues regarding the PSC's approval of the transfer of the assets of Lake Josephine Water to AquaSource Utility, Inc. First, we understand that Lake Josephine Water is serving outside of its certificated territory and this letter is AquaSource Utility, Inc.'s commitment to file an application with the Public Service Commission to amend its service area to include that territory which it is currently serving but which is not within its certificated service area. This application will be filed no later than 60 days after the effective date of the PSC Order approving of the transfer.

The second issue is that the books and records of Lake Josephine Water are not in compliance with the NARUC Uniform System of Accounts as required by Rule 25-30.115, Florida Administrative Code. By year end, the books and records for this system will be in compliance with the NARUC Uniform System of Accounts.
