<u>Issue 1</u>: Should the Settlement Agreement signed by Turkey Creek Utilities, the City of Alachua, and the Turkey Creek Master Owners Association be approved by the Commission? <u>Recommendation</u>: Yes, the Commission should approve the Settlement Agreement. Pursuant to that agreement, the utility should pay \$5,000 to the City of Alachua within 30 days of the Commission's Final Order approving the Settlement Agreement, and the City will then remit that amount to the Turkey Creek Masters Homeowners Association. Contingent upon such payment, the fine imposed by Order No. PSC-96-0350-FOF-WS should be permanently suspended, and the Commission should dismiss with prejudice the Circuit Court case and close Docket No. 921098-WS. Staff should be given the authority to administratively close the docket upon verification that the payment has been made.
