- 11. The Applicant currently does not provide local exchange or alternative exchange service.
- 12. The Applicant has never been denied certification by Florida, or any other State granting such authority.
- 13. There have never been any penalties imposed against the Applicant by Florida, or any other State.
- 14. No, there has never been any involvement in civil court proceeding with an interxchange carrier, local exchange company or other telecommunications entity by an officer, director, or shareholder, or by the company it self.
- 15. Upon authority being granted the Applicant by the State of Florida, the Applicant will establish for it's customers, a Customer Service Department (CSD) and a Network Operations Center (NOC) that will be manned 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Any customer of the Applicant will be able to contact a representative of the Applicant to file any necessary complaint, service order, billing question, or other such matter with this department.
- 16. There are no true financial statements for the Applicant. Although the corporation has been in existence since August of 1998, this project is to be a start-up company. There have been Two (1) Zero (\$0.00) dollar tax return filed with the IRS for 1998. The Applicant has produced a Business Plan, with the intention to raise capital for the projects contained within the plan. These projects are based on the Applicant receiving an ALEC license from the State of Florida. Initially, the start up capital will come from the company's two major shareholders and directors. If desired by the Commission, the Applicant can furnish this business plan for review.

The Applicant's plan initially is to "wholesale" data local exchange services to its network of resellers that have already been established. Additionally, the Applicant will use this license to provide to a company that is duly owned by Applicants two major shareholders, a more cost effective way of providing "Local Loop" service to their customers who purchase Internet Bandwidth from them.
