**Re: Notice of Cancellation of Transfer of Control of Florida Digital Network, Inc.,
to Elantic Communications, Inc.**

Dear Ms. Bayó:

By letter dated April 17, 2000, Florida Digital Network, Inc., ("Florida Digital") and Elantic Communications, Inc., ("Elantic") filed with the Commission an application for approval of transfer of control of Florida Digital to Elantic. Florida Digital was to become a subsidiary of Elantic by merger. The Commission opened Docket No. 000462-TP to process the companies' application. By Order No. PSC-00-1246-PAA-TP, issued July 10, 2000, and consummated by Order No. PSC-00-1428-CO-TP, issued August 3, 2000, the Commission approved the companies' application.

On behalf of Florida Digital, I hereby notify the Commission that the transfer of control and merger contemplated in the application has not and will not take place. While commission approval is required for a transfer of control to take place, once given, approval renders the transfer permissive and does not appear to constitute a directive. In any event, Florida Digital requests initiation of and participation in any docketed or undocketed activity deemed necessary for the Commission to accept/acknowledge this notification.
