Since there does not seem to be any on site sewage failures, this extension apears to be nothing more than another way to accommodate developers in their endeavor to economize their expenditures on the backs of the little people. This process of extending infrastructures into predominately rural areas is also one of the biggest contributors to sprawl. In turn this type development becomes the catapult for other environmental risks. In other words if government agencies were less eager to provide alternatives for these speculative investors, our lifestyle could be more conducive to improving our quality of life

The local governing body is also to blame for this disregard for our environment and how society must try to sensibly control growth. There is a better strategy for providing central sewage for communities. There are also sources for funding that have not even been considered by our local government.
