# 4.1. <u>Description of Rates and Charges for Message Toll Service</u>:

The service is flat rated and billed in an initial call interval of thirty (30) seconds, with additional intervals of six (6) seconds. The duration of each call will be rounded to the nearest higher increment for billing purposes. Additionally, fractional cents will be rounded to the nearest higher cent.
