Dear Mr. Lowe:

The Department has completed its review of the United Water Florida, Inc. (UWF), application to the Public Service Commission for an extension of its service area in Nassau County.

The area proposed by UWF for expansion of service includes areas designated in the Nassau County Comprehensive Plan, on the Future Land Use Map, as Medium-Density Residential (up to 5 dwelling units per acre), Low-Density Residential (up to 2 dwelling units per acre), and Conservation-Wetlands. The Department has no objection to UWF's proposed expansion to serve the areas designated on the Nassau County Future Land Use Map for Medium-Density Residential and Low-Density Residential development; however, the wetlands area in Section 56 of Township 3 North/Range 28 East will not need the provision of central water and sewer facilities and should be excluded from the proposed expansion area.

It should be noted that the Department received numerous letters from citizens concerned about the proposed extension of facilities into this area.
