ORDER APPROVING ADOPTION OF INTERCONNECTION, UNBUNDLING, RESALE AND COLLOCATION AGREEMENT

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 12,2000, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated (Sprint) and Allegiance Telecom of Florida, Inc. (Allegiance) filed a notice of adoption in its entirety of the interconnection, unbundling, resale and collocation agreement entered into and between Sprint and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc., pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §252(I) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). This agreement was approved by the Commission by Order No. PSC-97-0294-FOF-TP, issued on April 14, 1997, and is incorporated by reference herein. A copy of the agreement may be obtained by contacting our Division of Records and Reporting.

Both the Act and Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, encourage parties to enter into negotiated agreements to bring about local exchange competition as quickly as possible. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be

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submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(I) requires that a local exchange carrier shall make available any interconnection, service, or network element provided under an agreement approved by the state commission to any other requesting telecommunications carrier upon the same terms and conditions as those provided in the agreement in its entirety. Further, Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved.

The adoption of this agreement shall be effective on the date of issuance of this Order and will cover the 3 year period specified in the agreement. This agreement governs the relationship between the companies regarding physical collocation, local interconnection and the exchange of traffic pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 251. The agreement states that collocation space will be provided for Allegiance in Sprint's Central Offices and telecommunications service provided by Sprint for resale will be available for purchase by Allegiance. Rates for collocation space and telecommunications services are set out in the schedules included in the agreement. Under 47 U.S.C. § 252 (a)(1), the agreement shall include a detailed schedule of itemized charges for interconnection and each service or network element included in the agreement.

Upon review of the proposed adoption, we find that it complies with the Act; thus, we hereby approve it. Sprint and Allegiance are also required to file any subsequent supplements or modifications to this agreement with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Sprint-Florida, Incorporated and Allegiance Telecom of Florida, Inc.'s adoption in its entirety of Sprint-Florida, Incorporated and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc.'s interconnection, unbundling, resale and collocation agreement, incorporated by reference in this Order, is hereby approved. A copy of the agreement may be obtained as specified in the body of this Order. It is further.

ORDERED that any supplements or modifications to this agreement must be filed with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). It is further

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ORDERED that this docket is hereby closed.
