## DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should this docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes.

STAFF ANALYSIS: On May 25, 2000, Valencia Area Condominium Association, Inc. (Valencia) filed a petition for declaratory statement regarding the applicability of Rule 25-6.049(5)(a)3, Florida Administrative Code. Valencia sought a declaratory statement from the Commission indicating that Valencia A-I is exempt from the individual metering requirement in Rule 25-6.049(5)(a)3, Florida Administrative Code, and was thus eligible for metering through a single master meter. On August 1, 2000, Valencia filed an Amended Petition for Declaratory Statement.
