I have talked with Rosanne about whether this petition should be assigned a new docket or filed in Lindrick's Limited Proceeding, D. No. 980242-SU, which involves sewer only. Rosanne and I thought that it would probably be best to open a new docket -- this latest petition involves the failure of the utility to pay its bulk-water bill from the city -- which would be totally unrelated to the current docket. Rosanne wanted me to meet with Cathy Bedell on this, and I was trying to meet with her, but we keep missing each other. Joe Borda now says he will pay the bill and Troy Rendell (based on conversations with Marshall Willis) thinks that Steve Burgess may withdraw the motion. However, I have also been unable to reach Mr. Burgess. If Mr. Borda pays the bill as he says he will, then I believe this whole situation will resolve itself.
