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As discussed with Richard Redemann of the PSC staff, the Utility enlisted the services of a surveyor in order to provide with a description of the territory <u>as amended</u>, rather than simply a legal description of the new properties by metes and bounds or referenced quarter sections. As such, the notice provided includes the entire legal description of the existing and new areas combined for simplicity's sake. We have utilized that description in our noticing, and have modified our standard notice accordingly. Mr. Redemann agreed with this proposal for noticing.
