Re: Approval of an two Amendments to the Interconnection, Unbundling and Resale Agreement Negotiated by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") and IDS Long Distance, Inc. pursuant to Sections 251, 252 and 271 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996

Dear Mrs. Bayo:

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, BellSouth and IDS Long Distance, Inc. are submitting to the Florida Public Service Commission two amendments to their negotiated agreement for the interconnection of their networks, the unbundling of specific network elements offered by BellSouth and the resale of BellSouth's telecommunications services to IDS Long Distance, Inc. The Commission approved the initial agreement between the companies in Order No. 99-0660-FOF-TP issued April 6, 1999 in Docket 990148-TP.

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Act, the Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the negotiated agreement between BellSouth and IDS Long Distance, Inc. within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the agreement or any portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or the implementation of the agreement or any portion of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Both parties aver that neither of these reasons exist as to the agreement they have negotiated and therefore, are very hopeful that the Commission shall approve their agreement.

- 1. The following network elements located under Currently Combined of Exhibit C, Rates, of Attachment 2 of the March 27, 2000 Amendment, are hereby replaced with the network elements identified in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part of this Amendment:
 - NRC 2 Wire Voice Grade Loop/Line Port Combination 1st, with change USACC
 - NRC 2 Wire Voice Grade Loop/Line Port Combination- Addt'l, with change USACC
 - NRC 2 Wire Voice Grade Loop/Line Port Combination 1st, no change -USAC2
 - NRC 2 Wire Voice Grade Loop/Line Port Combination Addt'l, no change USAC2
