- 2. Telecommunications Act of 1996, requires that any such "agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission" 47 U.S.C. §252(e).
- 3. Sprint-Florida entered into an Agreement with BroadBand Office Communications, Inc. on June 21, 2000. The Agreement has been approved by the Commission pursuant to federal law. Order No. PSC-00-1873-FOF-TP states that "Sprint-Florida and BroadBand Office Communications, Inc. are also required to file any subsequent supplements or modifications to this agreement with the Commission".
- 4. In accordance with the above provisions, Sprint-Florida has entered into an Amendment to the Agreement with BroadBand Office Communications, Inc. This amendment was executed on October 6, 2000; and is attached hereto as Attachment A.
- 5. Under the Federal Act, an agreement (or amendment thereto) can be rejected by the State commission only if the commission finds that it discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or if the implementation of that agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2).
- 6. The Amendment with BroadBand Office Communications, Inc. does not discriminate against other similarly situated carriers which may order services and facilities from Sprint-Florida under similar terms and
