NOTICE is hereby given that the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission will conduct a customer meeting to discuss the application of Florida Public Utilities Company (Utility) for a limited proceeding to increase its water rates.

The rate increase has been requested to allow the Utility to cover the cost of significant capital improvements to the Utility's No. 3 Waterworks Plant along with some additional related plant improvements and associated direct expenditures not recovered in the Utility's recent rate proceeding in Docket No. 990535-WU. The system improvements are underway, and without the requested rate increase, the Utility projects that its return on investment will fall to 6.49% as of December 31, 2001.

# **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the meeting is to give customers and other interested persons an opportunity to offer comments regarding the quality of service the Utility provides, the proposed rate increase, and to ask questions and comment on other issues. Staff members will answer questions to the extent possible. All customers wishing to speak are urged to be present at the beginning of the customer meeting, since the meeting may be adjourned early if no customers are present. One or more of the Commissioners of the Florida Public Service Commission may attend and participate in the meeting. The meeting will begin as scheduled and will continue until all of the customers present have been heard.

Any person requiring some accommodation at the customer meeting because of a physical impairment should call the Division of Records and Reporting at (850) 413-6770 at least 48 hours prior to the meeting. The Utility has requested that it be allowed to increase its rates by \$240,558 per annum. The following is a comparison of the Utility's current rates to the requested rates. The final amount and timing of any increases will be determined by the Commission in this proceeding.
