NOCATEE'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE ADDITIONAL DIRECT TESTIMONY

NOCATEE UTILITY CORPORATION ("NUC") hereby files its Motion for Leave to File Additional Direct Testimony of Deborah D. Swain. As grounds therefor, NUC states:

- 1. In preparing its response to Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories and Second Request for Production of Documents, NUC discovered that a computational error had been made in the calculation of wastewater rates. This error resulted in proposed rates that would over-recover the wastewater revenue requirement.
- 2. By this motion, NUC seeks leave to file Additional Direct Testimony of Ms.

 Swain to correct the computational error and to furnish a REVISED Exhibit ____ (DDS-12) to present the revised wastewater rates. A copy of the testimony and exhibit are attached to this motion. The workpapers supporting this corrected computation are today being furnished to the parties in response to Staff's discovery requests.
- 3. The granting of this motion will give the Commission the information necessary to set appropriate wastewater rates for NUC.

4. Permitting NUC to file the additional direct testimony will not prejudice any other party. The deposition of Ms. Swain is currently scheduled for April 6, 2001 and the parties will have full opportunity to inquire into the wastewater rate computation at that time.

WHEREFORE, NUC urges that the Commission grant its request for leave to file the Additional Direct Testimony Ms. Swain, submitted concurrently herewith.

21	A.	This additional testimony corrects a computation error
22		in the calculation of wastewater rates that I
23		discovered when preparing a response to Staff's second
24		round of discovery to NUC in this case.

- Does that computation error affect any of your previous ο. 2 exhibits? Yes. It affects the presentation of wastewater rates on Α. 3 Exhibit (DDS-12) which was filed with my 4 5 supplemental direct testimony. A revised version of that exhibit, containing corrected wastewater rates and 6 comparing them to Intercoastal's rates, is attached as 7 to this testimony as Revised Exhibit (DDS-12). 9 Q. What was the cause of the error in the prior 10 computation? In computing the monthly rates required to recover the 11 Α. 12 wastewater revenue requirement, I inadvertently miscalculated the effect of defining a wastewater ERC 13 as 280 gallons per day (gpd) as compared to the water 14 ERC of 350 gpd. The effect was to produce rates that 15 over-recovered the wastewater revenue requirement. 16

- 20 proceeding?
- 21 A. Yes, they do.
