ALLIED/CFI'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Allied Universal Corporation ("Allied") and its affiliate, Chemical Formulators, Inc. ("CFI") (collectively "Allied/CFI"), by and through their undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, request confidential classification of the Force Majeure clause filed on a confidential basis by Tampa Electric Company ("TECO") on March 21 and 22, 2001, and state:

1. Allied/CFI requests confidential classification of the Force Majeure clause filed as Exhibit B to the Settlement Agreement between Allied/CFI and TECO. The same clause is Section 4 of the Contract Service Arrangement ("CSA") between Allied/CFI and TECO filed as Exhibit A to the Settlement Agreement, and thus is a subject of the Request for Confidential Classification filed by TECO on April 10, 2001, as to the CSA.

2. The Force Majeure clause is entitled to confidential classification and protection from public disclosure pursuant to Order No. 98-1081-FOF-EI, issued August 10, 1998 in Docket No. 980706-EI, approving TECO's Commercial/Industrial Service Rider ("CISR") tariff.

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

3. In approving confidential classification for documents filed pursuant to CISR tariffs, the Commission has stated that confidential classification is appropriate because public disclosure of the terms of CSAs would reduce the effectiveness of the CISR tariff in attracting at-risk load, and would impair the ability of utilities to negotiate favorable terms with potential CISR tariff customers for the benefit of the general body of ratepayers.

3. The Force Majeure clause has been treated as confidential by Allied/CFI and TECO and has not been publicly disclosed.

WHEREFORE, Allied/CFI requests that the Commission find that the Force Majeure clause in the Settlement Agreement and CSA between Allied/CFI and TECO is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.
