MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE DIRECT TESTIMONY

TCG South Florida and Teleport Communications Group (hereinafter referred to collectively as "TCG"), by and through undersigned counsel, respectfully moves the Commission for a one week extension of time to file direct testimony in the above docket, and as grounds therefor states:

- 1. Pursuant to Order No. PSC-01-0833-PCO-TP issued March 30, 2001, the direct testimony and exhibits are due to be filed in the instant docket on or before April 19, 2001.
- 2. Despite diligent effort, TCG will be unable to complete direct testimony by April 19, 2001 due to the resignation of Greg Follensbee, the former Director of Law and Government Affairs for AT&T's Southern Region.
- 3. Prior to his resignation, Mr. Follensbee was the witness designated by TCG to file direct testimony in the above docket, as AT&T acquired TCG in 1998.
