## PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF CONSERVATION PLANS

Comes now Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC") and requests the Commission to approve the Conservation Plan filed with the Commission in response to Order No. PSC-00-1029-PAA-EG. As grounds, FPUC would show:

1. This docket was initiated to establish numeric conservation goals for FPUC for the period 2001-2010. On April 11, 2000, FPUC submitted its goals and testimony regarding these goals for Commission review. Subsequent to this filing, the Commission issued its Notice of Proposed Agency Action Approving Numeric Conservation Goals in Order No. PSC-00-1029-PAA-EG on May 24, 2000 ("PAA Order"). There was no protest to the PAA and Order No. PSC-00-1110-CO-EG making the PAA Order the Final Order was issued June 19, 2000. The goals approved by the Commission were attached to the PAA Order.

2. The PAA Order directed that FPUC file a Demand Side Management Plan for approval by the Commission specifically defining the programs offered and the eligibility requirements. Pursuant to this requirement, FPUC timely submitted its plan consisting of an Executive Summary and descriptions of the programs offered. Copies were provided to the Commission and Staff. 3. Upon completion of the review of the plan, FPUC would request that the Commission issue its Order approving the plan as filed. FPUC believes that the plan and goals satisfy the requirements of the Commission orders and Rules 25-17.001 through 25-17.002, Florida Administrative Code, and therefore should be approved.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons cited, FPUC requests approval of its Demand Side Management Plan filed with the Commission in response to Order No. PSC-00-1029-PAA-EG.
