ALABAMA POWER COMPANY AND GULF POWER COMPANY'S MOTION TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL REPLY BRIEF OUT OF TIME

Pursuant to Rules 27 and 31 of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and Eleventh Circuit Rules 27-1 and 31-2, Alabama Power Company and Gulf Power Company (collectively "Petitioners") hereby file this Motion to File Supplemental Reply Brief Out of Time. On June 15, 2001, this Court issued an Order consolidating this proceeding, Case No. 01-13058-B, with the related consolidated proceedings in Case Nos. 00-14763-I and 00-15068-D, in which briefing was complete. It also allowed the parties to file supplemental briefs on the most recent order of the Federal Communications Commission and set a briefing schedule. As relevant to this Motion, the Order directed the Petitioners to file their supplemental reply brief, "within seven (7) days of service of Respondents' supplemental response brief."

The Certificate of Service accompanying the Respondents' Supplemental Response Brief was dated July 27, 2001. In accordance with Rule 26(c) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, the

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Petitioners' reply was due on August 6, 2001.¹ On August 6, 2001, the Petitioners submitted their Supplemental Reply Brief to the Clerk of this Court. Petitioners believe that their submission of the Supplemental Reply Brief on August 6, 2001 complies with the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and this Court's June 15, 2001 Order to file "within seven (7) days of service of Respondents' supplemental response brief."

On August 13, 2001, the Petitioners received the Clerk's August 9, 2001 Order stating that their Supplemental Reply Brief was due on August 3, 2001, and therefore had not been filed with the Court. The August 9, 2001 Order directed the Petitioners to file a motion to file the reply brief out of time. Accordingly, the Petitioners file this Motion and respectfully request that their Supplemental Reply Brief be filed in the above-styled consolidated cases and that the Court consider the brief in its review of the cases.

¹Rule 26(c) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure states: "When a party is required or permitted to act within a prescribed period after a paper is served on that party, 3 calendar days are added to the prescribed period unless the paper is delivered on the date of service stated in the proof of service." The Petitioners did not receive the Respondents' Supplemental Response Brief on the "date of service stated in the proof of service" (July 27, 2001). Therefore, their Supplemental Reply Brief was due within 7 days of service <u>plus</u> 3 days as prescribed by Rule 26(c) (August 6, 2001).
