BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., ("BellSouth") pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files this Request for Confidential Classification, and states the following:

- 1. On October 8, 2001, BellSouth filed late-filed hearing exhibits identified as Late-File Hearing Exhibits 8, 13, 15, 17, and 36. At that same time, BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification, indicating its intent to ask for confidential classification of information contained in the Late-Filed Hearing Exhibits 8, 15, and 17.
- 2. BellSouth hereby withdraws its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification for Late-Filed Hearing Exhibit 15.
- 3. BellSouth hereby files this Request for Confidential Classification of Late-Filed Exhibits 8 and 17. The information contained in these exhibits furnished by BellSouth includes confidential business information. Attachment "A" to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification contains the specific justification for the request

for confidential classification along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.

Explanation of Proprietary Information

- This information contains substantive references to a commercial arbitration award dated June 5, 2001. Both BellSouth and Supra are bound by the existing Interconnection Agreement to keep the results of the arbitration confidential. Since the public release of this information is contractually prohibited, it is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes.
- 2. The information requested contains practices/procedures utilized by BellSouth to conduct business. This information, if released, would allow BellSouth's competitors to have free access to certain intellectual property which was developed at significant expense to BellSouth. BellSouth's competitors can use this information to develop their own strategies without the burden and expense of developing this property for themselves. Thus, the disclosure of this information to BellSouth's competitors would impair BellSouth's ability to compete and the information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes. In addition, this information, which BellSouth keeps as trade secrets, is valuable because it is used by BellSouth in conducting its business. Therefore, this information should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information exempt from the Open Records Act.
