BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Request For Confidential Classification, and states the following:

- 1. On October 9, 2001, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. filed its Supplemental Response to Florida Digital Network's ("FDN") First Request for Production of Documents, Item No. 1. The Response contains confidential business information that is considered confidential and proprietary to BellSouth.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.06(3)(a), BellSouth is now filing a Request for Confidential Classification for the subject information because the information contained in BellSouth's Supplemental Response to FDN's First Request for Production of Documents Item No. 1 which contains customer-specific information and confidential business information that is considered confidential and proprietary to BellSouth.
