CASE BACKGROUND

In its June 16, 2000, Petition for Arbitration, AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. and TCG South Florida (collectively "AT&T") sought resolution of issues in the interconnection negotiations between it and BellSouth Telecommunications Inc. (BellSouth). An administrative hearing was held on February 14-15, 2001. By Order No. PSC-01-1402-FOF-TL, issued June 28, 2001, the Commission rendered its decision in this arbitration.

On July 13, 2001, both AT&T and BellSouth timely filed separate motions for reconsideration of Order No. PSC-01-1402-FOF-TL. On July 25, 2001, BellSouth filed its Memorandum in Opposition to AT&T's Motion for Reconsideration and Cross-Motion for Clarification. Extension of Time for the filing of the executed agreement. The Reconsideration Motions and related pleadings were addressed in Order No. PSC-01-1951-FOF-TP, issued on September 28, 2001.

On October 29, 2001, BellSouth submitted its petition for approval of its arbitrated interconnection, unbundling and resale agreements with AT&T. Though identical, two separate agreements were filed, one for AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. and the other one for TCG South Florida.

This is staff's recommendation for approval of the respective agreements between BellSouth and AT&T.

DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission approve the arbitrated interconnection, unbundling and resale agreements between BellSouth and AT&T in Docket No. 000731-TP?

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Yes. The Commission should approve the arbitrated interconnection, unbundling and resale agreements between BellSouth and AT&T in Docket No. 000731-TP. (**BARRETT**)

STAFF ANALYSIS: In its June 16, 2000, Petition for Arbitration, AT&T sought resolution of numerous issues in the interconnection negotiations between it and BellSouth. The administrative hearing was held on February 14-15, 2001. The parties reached settlement on certain issues prior to the Commission's decision, and in Order No. PSC-01-1402-FOF-TL, issued June 28, 2001, the Commission resolved the remaining issues set forth in this arbitration.

On July 13, 2001, Motions for Reconsideration from both AT&T and BellSouth were filed. On July 25, 2001, BellSouth filed its Memorandum in Opposition to AT&T's Motion for Reconsideration and Cross-Motion for Clarification. On July 30, 2001, BellSouth filed a Motion for Extension of Time for the filing of the executed agreement. The Reconsideration Motions and related pleadings were addressed in Order No. PSC-01-1951-FOF-TP, issued on September 28, 2001. DOCKET NO. 000731-TP DATE: November 19, 2001

On October 29, 2001, BellSouth submitted its petition for approval of its arbitrated interconnection, unbundling and resale agreements with AT&T. Though identical, two separate agreements were filed, one for AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. and the other one for TCG South Florida. The agreements are filed pursuant to the Final Orders in this docket, Order Nos. PSC-01-1402-FOF-TL and PSC-01-1951-FOF-TP.

Staff has reviewed the said agreements and believes they comply with the Commission's decisions in Order Nos. PSC-01-1402-FOF-TL and PSC-01-1951-FOF-TP, as well as the Act. Staff, therefore, recommends that the Commission approve BellSouth's arbitrated interconnection, unbundling and resale agreements with AT&T.

ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Yes. If the Commission approves staff's recommendation in Issue 1, no further action will be required in this docket. Therefore, this docket may be closed. (**FORDHAM**)
